



Journées Codage et Cryptographie (C2) 2023 call for proposals

The J-C2 participants are encouraged to submit talks' proposals in an **at most one page long** .pdf file on the following submission website :

The talk's purpose can be either a work in progress or an already submitted or published contribution.

Format. The proposal should be organised as follows :

- Title.
- Your name *i.e.* that of the **speaker**.
- Your **current** affiliation and status. If you are PhD student, precise in which year of PhD you are **when submitting**.
- If the results are part of a collaboration, the list of co-authors should appear **separately** as *Collaboration with <name of the co-authors>*.
- Abstract.

Submission dead line. Friday May 26th Wednesday May 31st, 2023, 23h59 CEST.

Language. The abstract and the talk may be either in french or in english. In order to help non french speaking participants, GT C2 encourages speakers to do their slides in english (not mandatory).

Decision. Only talks in the scope of GT C2¹ will be accepted. If their number is too large to accept all of them, the program committee will follow this list of priorities

1. ATER's, Post-doctorants and $\geq 3^{\text{rd}}$ -year PhD students (when submitting).
2. 2nd-year PhD students.
3. 1st-year PhD students.
